When a team is struggling to get results, nothing or very little seems to go for them. Poole's opening goal definitely had a massive bearing on the outcome as video footage showed a clear mistake from the match officials. Let's hope that the old adage of things evening out in football rings true.

An injury hit Yellows with a schedule of three games in seven days, including the previous FA Trophy match at Havant & Waterlooville, made four changes. A precautionary and sensible team selection saw Toby Down, Tor Swann, Zack Williams and Louis Jagger Cane start with Dean Moxey, Corey Koerner, Gabe Billington and Dan Koita, the majority injured in the FA Trophy game, not named in Asa Hall and Steve Orchard's matchday eleven.

Poole are having a bit of a resurgence this season and are very much in the early playoff picture. This was always going to be a testing evening, with many established players at this level in the Dolphins line up.

It was not surprising given their recent setbacks that Tiverton were not particularly fluent in the early stages of this game and it was the visitors who looked more convincing in their forays into the opposing half and the alert Brooklyn Wilkins had already cleared off the line after five minutes, before the award of a penalty for the Dolphins'.

Sustained pressure forced a corner in the eleventh minute and when centre back

Josh Staunton headed in the area; the ball hit a Tivvy hand. Striker Shaquille Gwengwe's powerfully struck and well directed effort from the spot, produced an absolutely stunning reflex save from George Burton, whose fully outstretched arm parried away, although, seconds after Tivvy fans were marvelling at Burton's brilliance, the penalty taker fell to the ground, barely touched in the box, under the close attention of Brooklyn Wilkins, but over went Gwengwe, whose theatrics were enough to fool the referee, who again pointed to the spot.

Mistakes are made on a football field and that was a clear one. A second penalty was put away by Gwengwe and once again only a little way into a game, the Yellows were trailing. Tivvy brushed off that disappointment and Finn Rooke made good contact on a Tor Swann cross but over went his header. It was a spirited reaction in adversity and the Yellows settled into a better groove. They were playing with good poise.

But in the 28th minute, what is becoming a worrying trait was replicated once again by the Yellows. Careless in possession, the ball was easily intercepted, and Tiverton were cut open with a few slick passes, and the cultured IK Hill supplied a second goal for the Dolphins.

Undeterred by their predicament, the rest of the half saw Tiverton having the lion's share of possession and made some inroads into Poole's defence. Louis Jagger Cane using the ball wisely in the final third and Tor Swann teasing and tormenting on the wing.

A fine piece of forward play from Jagger Cane, who controlled neatly before expertly setting up Toby Stephens on the edge of the box, resulted in the talented midfielder skidding a shot just wide of the left upright. A couple of corners were won on the edge of half time and then Zack Williams nimbly shifted the ball past the Dolphins last defender. A moment's hesitation though allowed Adam Parkes to come off his line and get there first. His clearance however landed at the feet of Finn Rooke. He was unable though to find an unguarded net and 2-0 in arrears it remained at the break.

When going behind further at 2-0, the effort couldn't be faulted and Tivvy were quickly back on the front foot when the game resumed. Poole were reduced to playing mainly on the break and Burton made another decent stop low down in the 49th minute.

Tiverton then increased the intensity and when they recycled the ball after winning a corner, an eye-catching piece of wing play from Swann ended with him crossing to Asa Hall and his headed attempt was successful and Parkes was emphatically beaten.

Continuing to press with confidence and with some attractive build up play, with Toby Stephens becoming more influential, Hall fired shots that although didn't trouble Parkes, signalled the Yellows intent.

A Dolphins player aggressively pushed Brooklyn Wilkins' to the ground when he tried to prevent a quickly taken free kick, but a card of neither colour was forthcoming. A good attempt from Jagger Cane was a fraction too high and Aiden Horne replaced Zack Williams in the 73rd

minute, who'd had a decent return to the side.

Some excellent covering round on a couple of occasions from Brooklyn Wilkins and a crucial tackle from the same player, kept Tivvy's determined hunt for an equaliser on course. The heavily grassed pitch came to our rescue as the ball held up on Kris Campbell who had been played through by Poole's best player on the night IK Hill. That happened in the 76th minute and Tiverton then threw all they could at the Dolphins, who defended well. Their backline often closing the door with last-ditch blocks and tackles.

Tiverton were relentless and in the seven minutes added time and Fin Rooke, still yet to open his Yellows account, came closest to rescuing a deserved leveller, as his low driven shot went agonisingly just the other side of the post. Poole held on and this was a result that was difficult to take, for all Yellows present.

Like most of the season, there was plenty to encourage on Tuesday night and we were very unfortunate with the second penalty award, but we need to start turning promising performances into points winning ones.

Our media team caught up with Toby in the summer, fresh from signing on the dotted line and he said: "I`m really proud to be joining Tiverton Town and already looking forward to what the future holds. I`ve played here a few times before with my previous clubs and I know from that the fans are great here; they really get behind their team. Can`t wait to meet them all and show them what I can do".

More recently, on the season so far, "It's been strange for us. We're obviously a completely new group from that of last season, bar a couple of the lads, and I certainly believe that our performances haven't been reflected in some of the results we've been on the wrong end of and where we are in the table now but I also believe that we're not far away from clicking together and hopefully we can string some results together and get ourselves away from the wrong end of the league table".


Having been in Southampton's youth academy for about five years, Toby moved to Yeovil Town and signed his first

professional contract for The Glovers as a 17-year-old and on 8th May 2021, he made his National League debut as a substitute for Yeovil at Wrexham's Racecourse Ground. By then, he had already taken in loan spells at both Hemel Hempstead Town, Truro City and Plymouth Parkway, developing skills that, as a young Chelsea fan, he had modelled on the goalscoring midfielder Frank Lampard, while growing up in the village of Ashcott in Somerset.

Following his release from Yeovil, Toby joined AFC Totton, where he hit the ground running and scored on his U23 debut to round out a 4-1 home win over Dorchester Town in the Hampshire Combination & Development Football League U23 Premier Division encounter and he only had to wait a short while to make his first team debut, coming on for Charlie Austin as a secondhalf sub in the 2-1 home win over Swindon Supermarine, and then he also featured in a victory over Chertsey Town a few days later.

In March of this year Toby then signed for Hungerford Town and he made his debut for his new club in a 2-0 win over Plymouth Parkway at Bolitho Park.



MEET THE VISITORS

The new club was formed in 2009 under experienced manager Micky Vipond and won the Molten Spartan South Midlands League Division 2 title in its first season, losing only once each at home and away.

The team were again champions in 201011, this time by 15 points and were
unbeaten at home in the league with the
final total of 107 points highest in the
season for any club in the non-league
pyramid that season, prompting the Herts
FA to award the club the prestigious Sir
Stanley Rous Memorial Trophy (named
after a former local referee and
administrator who rose all the way from
West Herts. football to the top job at FIFA).

This second successive promotion was into to the Spartan Premier division, where the club then stayed for 6 years. The team then won promotion to the Southern League Central division 1 under Steve Bateman by finishing as Premier division runners up in 2018, helped by Matt Bateman's 44 goals, and in 2020 Berko were leading the Southern League Central Division 1 when the season was abandoned due to the pandemic.

The club then finished as runners-up in 2022 but went out at home to North Leigh in the play off semifinal after extra time. Finally, in 2023, the club earned its overdue and well-deserved promotion, winning the title by a 19-point margin, and completing a notable double, also winning the Herts Senior Cup beating Hitchin Town on penalties in the final, having knocked out Watford U23 on the way.

As well as winning four divisional team of the month awards, the Comrades were

awarded the Sir Stanley Rous Memorial Trophy for the second time.

The club made its FA Cup debut in 2011 with an away win over Crawley Green, followed by a trip to Clarence Park, but the game with St Albans City was goalless, then exiting at Broadwater. In 2022/23, Berko went on a strong run knocking out Ware, Witham Town, and Concord Rangers at home before going down in the 3rd qualifying round 2-0 at Banbury United, who like Concord were two divisions higher up the pyramid than the Comrades. To date, this is the club's furthest progress in the FA Cup, an achievement matched in 2023/24 with another run to the 3rd qualifying round ending with a 1-0 defeat at AFC Totton.

2023/24 also saw Berkhamsted challenge for the first time at step 3 level but ultimately end in disappointment and relegation back to the Southern Central Division 1.

2024/25 Saw the Comrades promoted to Step 3 for the second time in their history after beating Flackwell Heath 5-0 in front of a record crowd (1,963) in the Southern League Div One Central Play off Final.

The club nickname is "the Comrades" in recognition of the club being formed in the town by servicemen returning from the First World War more than 100 years ago.

Berkhamsted FC also run a midweek side for under 18s in the Southern Counties Floodlit Youth League, and a lady's team who play on Sundays in the Beds. &; Herts Women's League.

CUSTOM METAL PLAQUE Charlie Horlock (Goalkeeper) The experienced 'keeper joined from Slough Town for whom he made 54 appearances last season. Before that, Charlie played 273 games at Hitchin Town, having started his career with Wycombe Wanderers and Stevenage.

Matt Burch (Goalkeeper) No 2 goalkeeper who made his full debut for the comrades last year in the FA Trophy vs AFC Dunstable and pulled off a fantastic performance and series of penalty saves

Jack Tompkins (Defender) Talented right back, who's now racked up 80 games in his two spells at Berko. Charlie Johnson (Defender) Another centre half, who joined Berko in November 2024 and played a full part in the promotion campaign, making 23 appearances and scoring his first goal for the club at Aylesbury on Boxing Day.

Former clubs include Cambridge Utd, St. Ives and Royston Town.

Max Rosner (Defender) The young centre back has already made 115 senior appearances with 7 goals, a great record for such a young player. Rozzie scored twice in his 25 appearances for the Comrades last season, and before joining us in October 2024, had previously played for Hemel Hempstead, Bedford Town and AFC Dunstable.

James Gurteen (Defender) The 26-yearold joins from Harrow Borough, for whom he made 49 appearances last season. James has also played at Rayners Lane and Bracknell Town and looks set to play an important part for the Comrades this season.

Kwadwo Kyei (Defender) Powerfully built left back who came on board this summer. Explosive going forward and hard to beat, Kwad has played at Hertford Town, AFC Dunstable and Slough Town, before joining the Hertford Town, AFC Dunstable & Slough Town before joining the comrades

Cameron Hyde (Midfielder) Cam is an experienced wide player, with over 250 senior appearances. He was the stand-out at Barton Rovers, playing nearly a hundred games over the last two seasons, and has also played at Chesham, Bedford, Kempston and Biggleswade Utd.

Adam Watkins (Midfielder) The veteran is still the main man in the Comrades midfield. With well over 500 appearances and 68 goals under his belt, including sixty games as a pro at Luton, Ads has now played over 100 games for Berko, adding to his distinguished career with clubs that also include Kidderminster Harriers, Eastleigh, Bedford Town, Royston Town, Chesham and Cambridge City.
